Gary Schneider: In a smart, dramatic debut Schneider lines the small back room here with nine large, turn-of-the-century portraits of women that have been blown up from fragile *carte de visite* negatives. Though the flawed surfaces suggest a Starnesque attack on the conventional image, the subjects—their yearning, wariness, contempt, or confusion preserved a century later—gaze out at us with a complicated humanity that's both eloquent and seductive.
